New Business:

Currently 48 of the 52 volunteers have been confirmed to run the games. Susan Flechtner's Brownie Girl Scout Troop may sell caramel apples to raise money for the troop. Mr. Hall and Mrs. Gelinas have agreed to be the targets for the "Pie in the Face" game.
