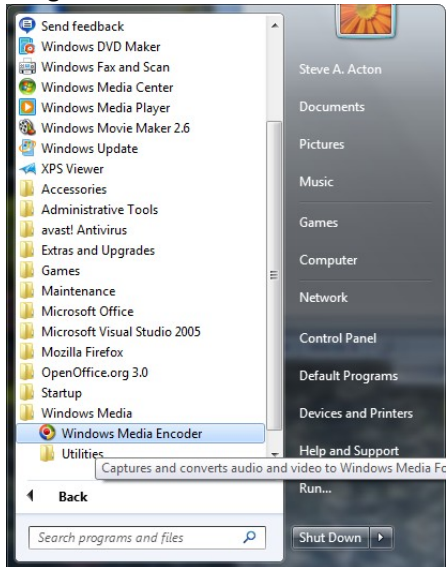
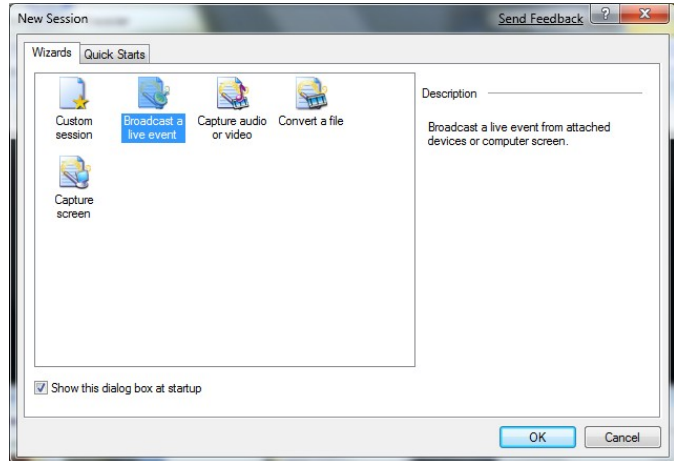


Using Windows Encoder

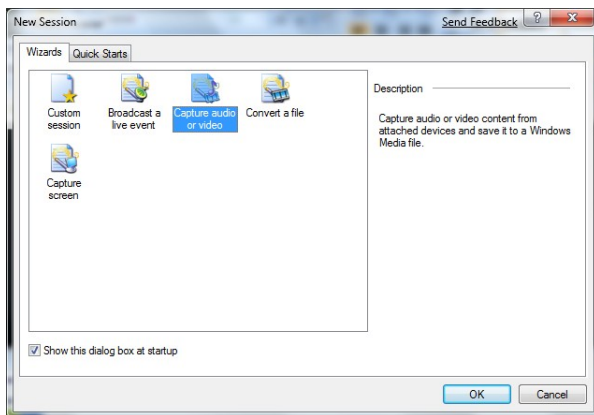
Windows Media Encoder is located under Program Files – Windows Media



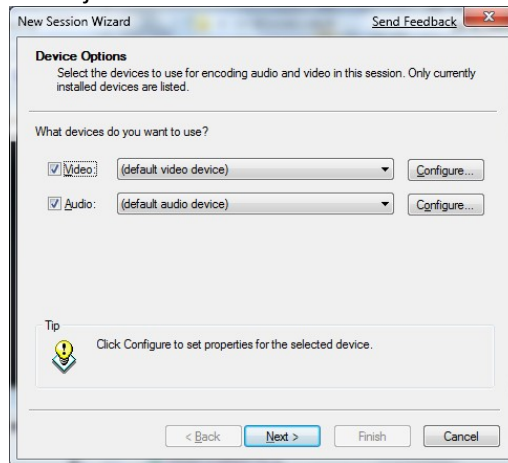
The new session wizard pops up. This is where you can capture video & audio or capture computer screen.



The capture audio video through webcam use the Button shown below:

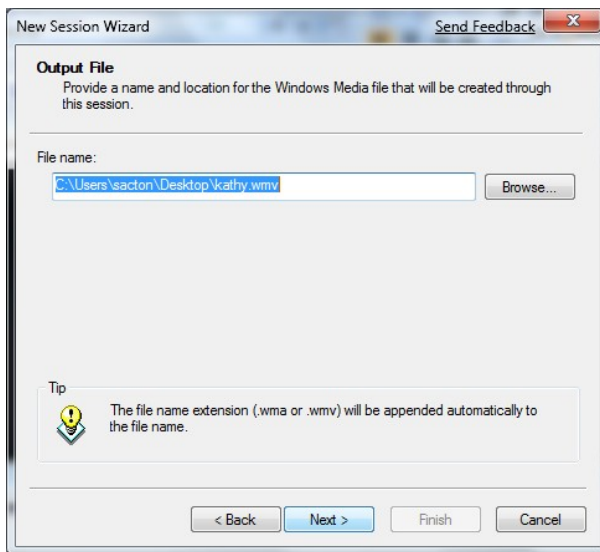


If your webcam and microphone are hooked up ok just click next:

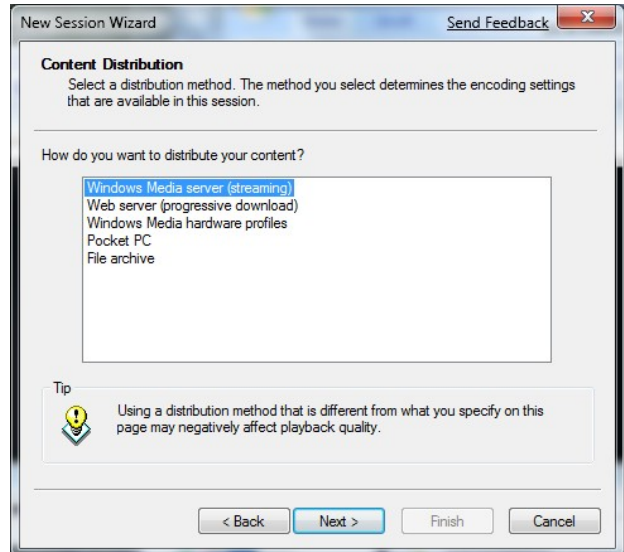

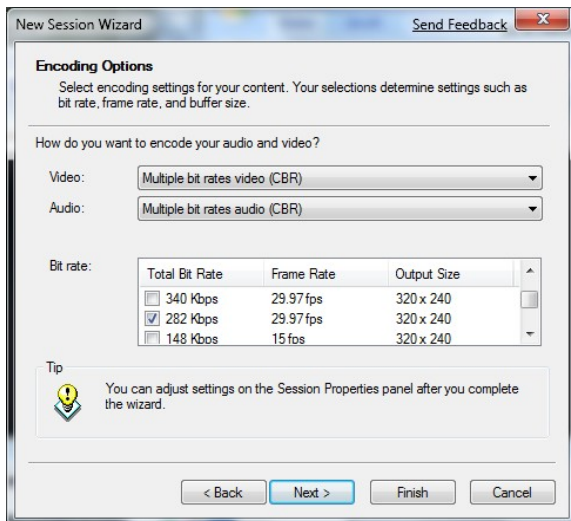
Now you can have it save where you want just Browse to that location and click next.



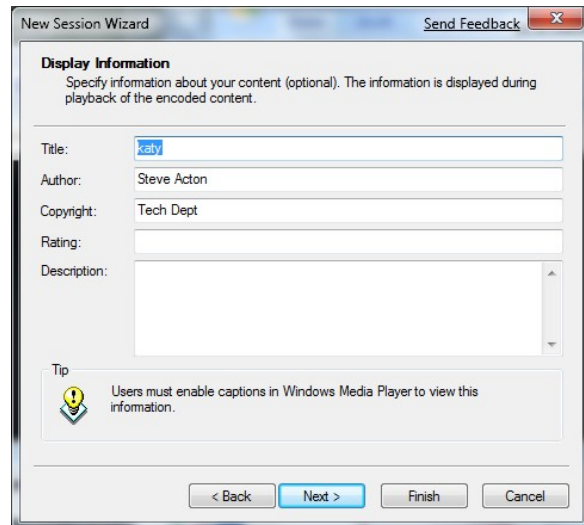
This format is fine for recording; click next



This rate of 262, which is the default is fine Click next:

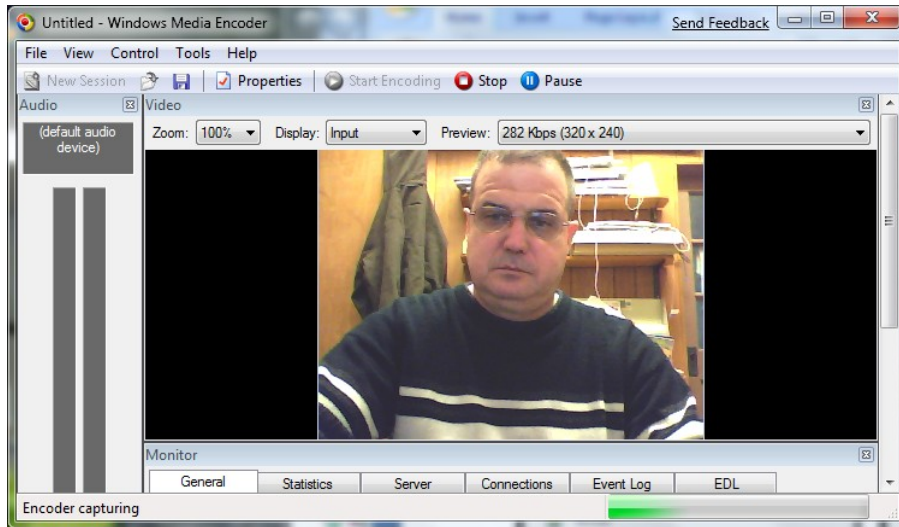


At this point click finish:

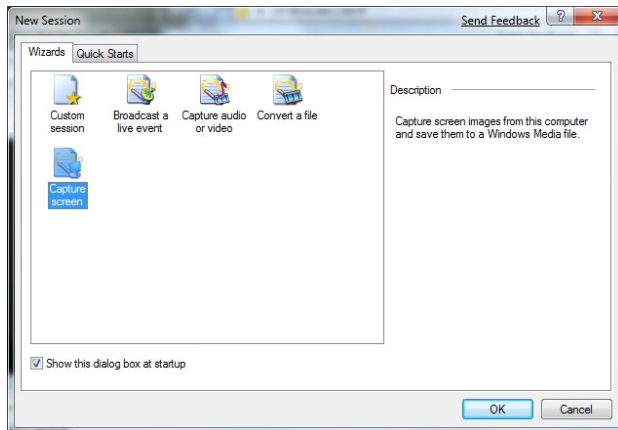

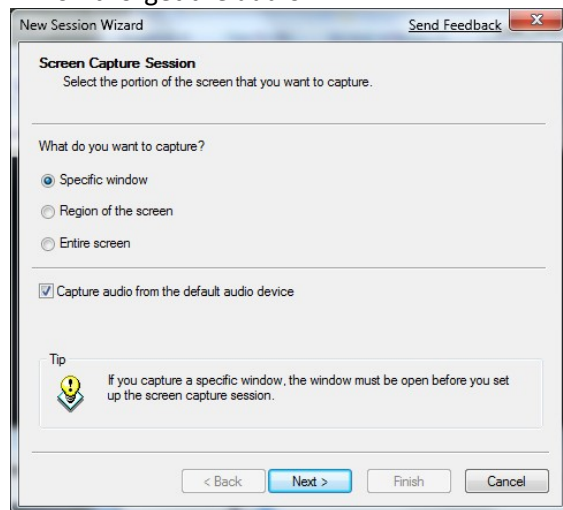
At this point you can click on the start encoding and when your finished click on the stop. It will ask to save your file when you close out.



Now lets capture the screen using the capture Screen as shown below:



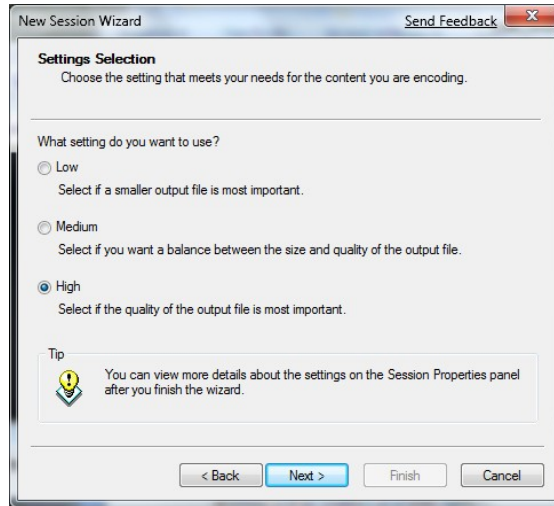
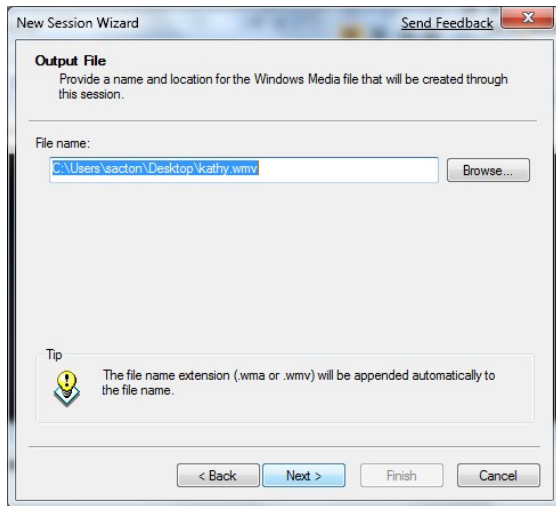
Now you can choose either option below. Don't forget the audio.



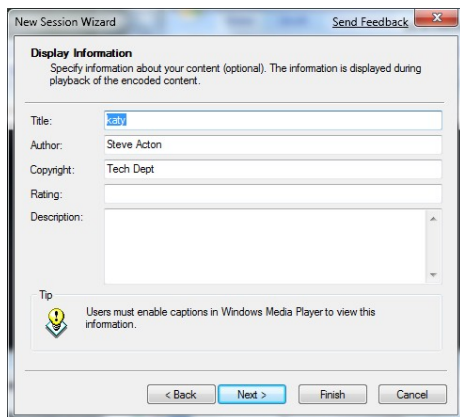

Now you can have it save where you want just Browse to that location and click next.

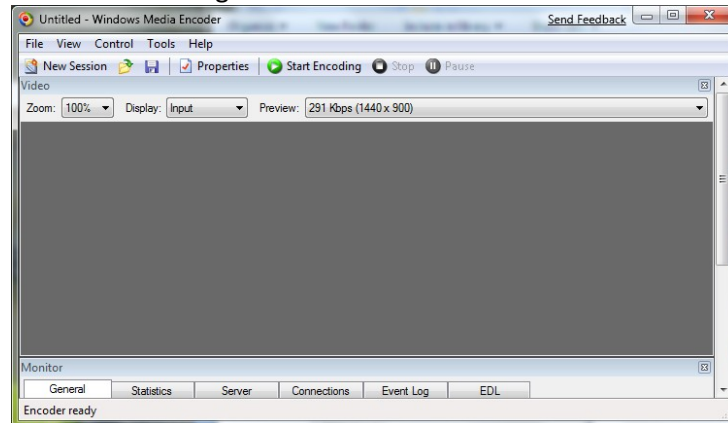
I have had the best luck with The High format.



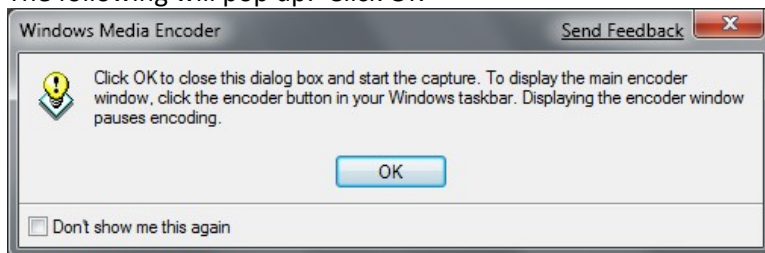
At this point click finish:
